Post-Operative Instructions for Hernia Surgery

- 1. **Dressing**: If there is an outer dressing on your wound, you may remove this in two days. If steri-strips are in place (white tapes) leave them in place. They will fall off on their own or your physician may remove them.
- Showering/Baths: Unless otherwise instructed by your surgeon, you may begin showering in two days. The steri-strips can get wet. Leave them in place. Please avoid baths and submersion of the incision for at least 2 weeks.
- 3. Diet: You may resume your regular diet.
- 4. **Medications**: You have been prescribed the following medications (checked):
 - Narcotic: _____ Take 1-2 tabs by mouth every 4 6 hours as needed for pain. Do not drive a car or operative heavy machinery within 24 hours of taking these pills
 - o Toradol: Take every 6 hours for the next 3 days until finished
 - Antibiotic: _____ Use as directed
 - Stool Softner: Colace 100 mg, twice daily. Purchase this or any other stool softener over the counter and use while takings pain medications.

- 5. **Home Medications**: Resume all your prior home medications. Aspirin/Plavix are ok. Coumadin/Lovenox check with your doctor.
- 6. Ice Packs: An ice pack may be applied to the area as needed for swelling.
- 7. Activity: As tolerated. Let pain be your guide. If it hurts, do not do it.
- 8. **Follow up**: Schedule an appointment to see your surgeon in _____ days. Please call (424) 279-8222
- 9. **Questions**: Contact your surgeon for excessive bleeding, fever, redness or drainage by the incision, pain not relieved by the medication prescribed, or any other questions or concerns.
